




# RECOVERY HOUSING SUPPORT

The Foundation of Recovery offers individuals **up to 12 weeks of financial support in recovery housing.** The financial assistance is intended to provide the recipient with meaningful support allowing for a stable and successful recovery. The goal of this program is for individuals to rapidly gain independence and personal responsibility across a 12-week period.

### A NEW TOOL FOR WITHDRAWL

Lucemyra is the first and only non-opioid prescription medicine used in adults to help with the symptoms of opioid withdrawal.

This medication will not completely prevent the symptoms of opioid withdrawal and is not a treatment for OUD. It helps restore chemical balance and helps relieve the symptoms that occur during opioid withdrawal. Based on survey result from patients in a clinical study, Lucemyra provided the biggest improvement in symptom relief on Day 2 and Day 3 of opioid withdrawal, when symptoms were often most severe.
