



NEW HOPE IN MATERNAL CARE

Tucked away in a Kettering neighborhood, the Miami Valley Hospital program **Promise to Hope** helps connect opioid-addicted mothers to treatment for moms and their babies during pregnancy and for up to a year after the birth. The city is also home to **Brigid's Path**, the first facility in Ohio and the second in the nation to offer an in-patient, home-like approach to serving babies born exposed to addictive substances.

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FAMILY CENTERED SERVICES

Maternal Addiction Programs are designed for a continuum of care for women and their children suffering from the effects of addiction. These programs address the complex needs of pregnant women and new moms in recovery for substance use disorder while also providing wraparound services for women and their children
