



Prosperity for All (PfA) is a visionary pilot program developed through the Cincinnati USA Regional Chamber "Leadership Action Team" in the fight against poverty.

Poverty doesn't have to be a generational malady. PfA empowers the willing and capable to break the cycle. Upon completing the program, PfA graduates are capable of financially providing for their family and weaning themselves off of public assistance. PfA ultimately seeks to alter Ohio's laws and requirements for individuals receiving Ohio Works First (OWF) subsidies and enrollees in Ohio's Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) cash assistance program.

What sets PfA apart is that, in addition to helping current subsidy recipients, PfA is an effective ally in assisting Ohio's employers to fill open, well-paying positions.

Started in September 2016, this two-year pilot program is the first of its type in Ohio and is facilitated by Easterseals in partnership with Hamilton County Job and Family Services.

Differentiating Interventions

- Waiving of Ohio Works First work participation requirements during enrollment, allowing focus on career advancement
- Intensive case management with no more than 20:1 caseloads, allowing for personalized support
- Paid training in sector-based high-demand pathways
- Engagement of local business partners for job shadowing, interviews and potential employment


